
SUMMARY OF THE FIRST COMMUNITY SURVEY

COMMUNITY SURVEY SUMMARY

- We received over 160 survey responses and comments from the community
 - 39 online surveys completed
 - 26 live zoom poll responses
 - 22 comments through zoom chat
 - 48 areas of interest identified from interactive mapping
 - 30 mail-in comment cards received

ZOOM CHAT

(From February 3, 2022 Community Meeting)

"Library administration with branch in area."

Vision/Hopes

"Perhaps have benches, tables at the open spaces at the beginning of the boardwalk on the top. place for relaxation and rest." "I wish to see an expansion of medical treatment especially since this is the closest medical treatment facility to the north end of the island, and the population is the heaviest on the north and east side of the island."

"Thank you, Lance, for addressing our medical needs on this side of the island. I believe we are still the most populated side of the island, so we really do need more services. It is really a concern especially during another disaster occurrence."

"I would like to see the area for the police substation used as a specialty medical clinic such as a lab, women's clinic or pediatric clinic etc. The ER service really needs to expand as a true ER and not an urgent care clinic"

"I think a community asset to this proposed project would be additional facilities for an affordable senior housing and a preschool. Funds for a new library in this plan can be used for suggested assets listed above as we already have a library at Kapa'a High, Kapa'a EL & the Kapa'a library (that could use improvements to the existing facility). I like having that option for a pharmacy in the hospital."

Other Concerns

"Housing shortage is a major issue on Kaua'i. With affordable housing being prioritized, and multi-generational residents living closer to the elementary school and Mahelona (vs. near the boardwalk), it is not an equitable solution to move the police station closer to those residents. The idea of turning that location into a high-end rental is absurd."

"Less building and less congestion. If the limit is placed on housing the hospital and recovery space of this property might be healthier."

"I appreciate having these opportunities to share our views... So please let's plan for traffic as we progress on this vision."

Police Substation

"My husband and I are tired of all the sketchy activity on Nunu and Pelehu Roads and were hoping having KPD nearby would have a positive affect."

"I think the police substation should be located with the fire substation"

"please no retail or police substation!"

"CONTROL CRIME in the crime areas: Kapaʻa town, Upper Kawaihau near Kapahi Park and utilize Kaʻapuni bypass road"

"Kealia Fire Dept has issues with ongoing salt spray from the ocean that damages the facility and communications equipment, along with being in the inundation zone. Thanks for mentioning that part especially! Police Substation makes sense within Mahelona if relocating in Kapa'a."

INTERACTIVE MAPPING ACTIVITY

"Affordable housing is too dense. Prefer 2-story, not 3-story!"

"A combination senior center AND preschool!"

"Yes, a police station and library bordering Kawaihau. A park makai to take advantage of the great view. Some affordable housing in between. Walking/bike paths with trees connecting park, boardwalk, library."

"Not a good site for KPD. We don't want the relocation of crime and traffic to Iwaena."

"I hope the open space will be saved (as much as possible). A park or some open use for the community that maintains the spectacular view would be great! I always feel blessed on walks back there."








OPTIONS COMPARISON





- Compact hospital campus with pedestrianoriented "main street" along Kawaihau Rd.
- Network of walkways connecting the boardwalk, village green, and bluff park
- Library and triangular park at Iwaena Rd.
- Teacher/healthcare workers' and DHHL housing, residential psych and Easter Seals facility along Nunu Rd.



Option B: Duo Village Greens

- Dual village greens at opposite ends of a loop. road and senior assisted living overlooking a large bluff park.
- Community retail and medical uses along Kawaihau Rd.
- Kapa'a Police Substation and other housing uses along Nunu Rd.



Option C: The Bluff


- Compact hospital campus with village green, retail, library, teacher/healthcare workers' housing along Kawaihau Rd.
